

Situation 1 - The ball crosses and hits beyond the hazard - but the ball kicks back into the hazard and is found. You have two options:

- 1. You can play it as it lies - move the ball 1 club length no closer to the hole keeping it in the same condition it was found. No penalty.**
- 2. You may drop the ball within 2 club lengths of where it crossed the hazard - 1 stroke penalty. If the ball is not found, you may drop the ball within 2 club lengths of where it crossed the hazard - 1 stroke penalty.**
